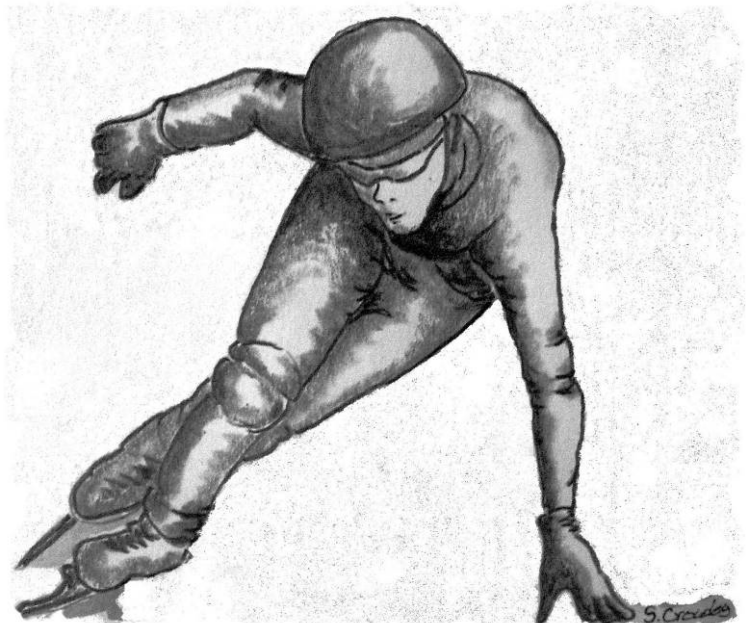

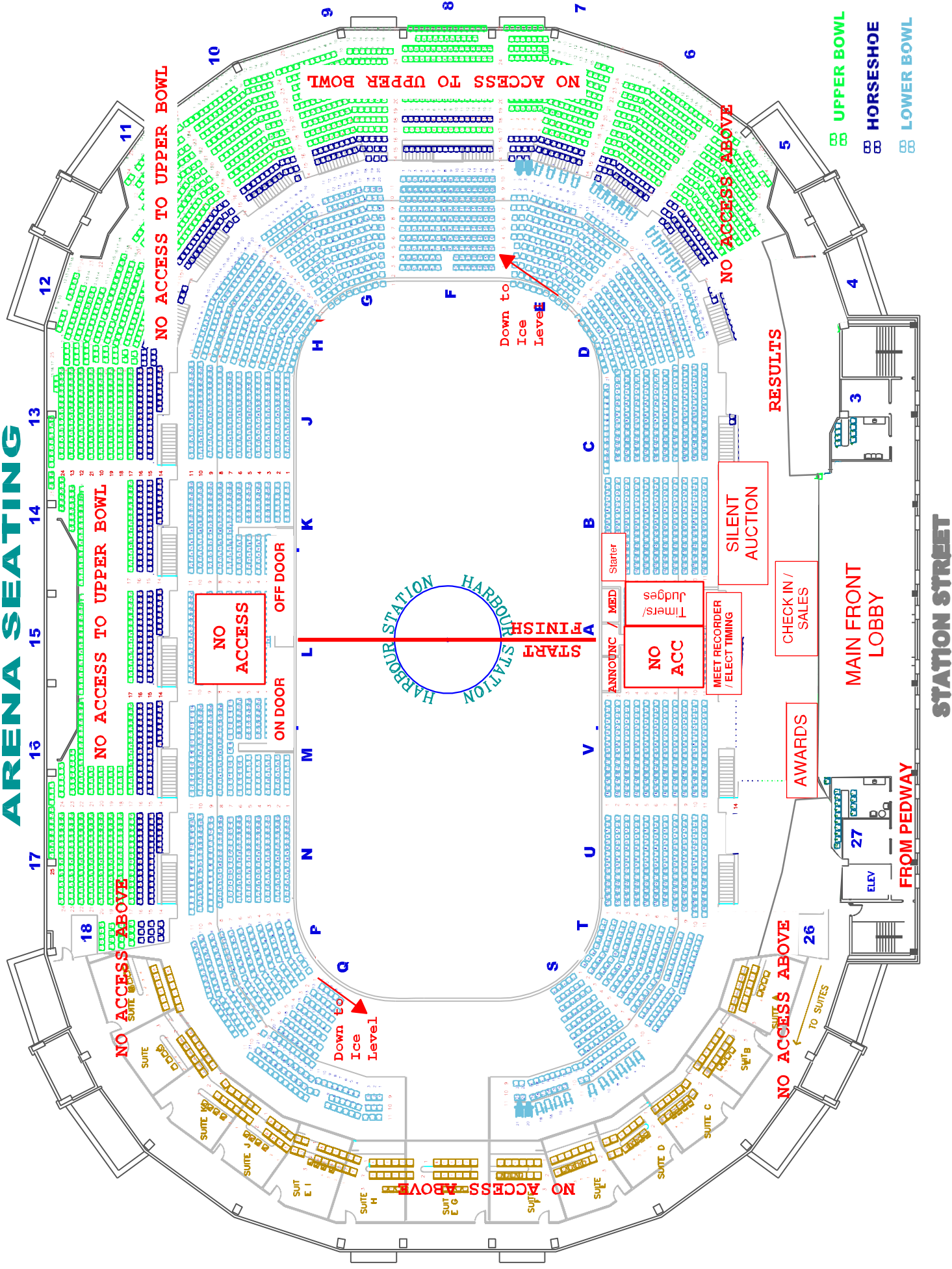

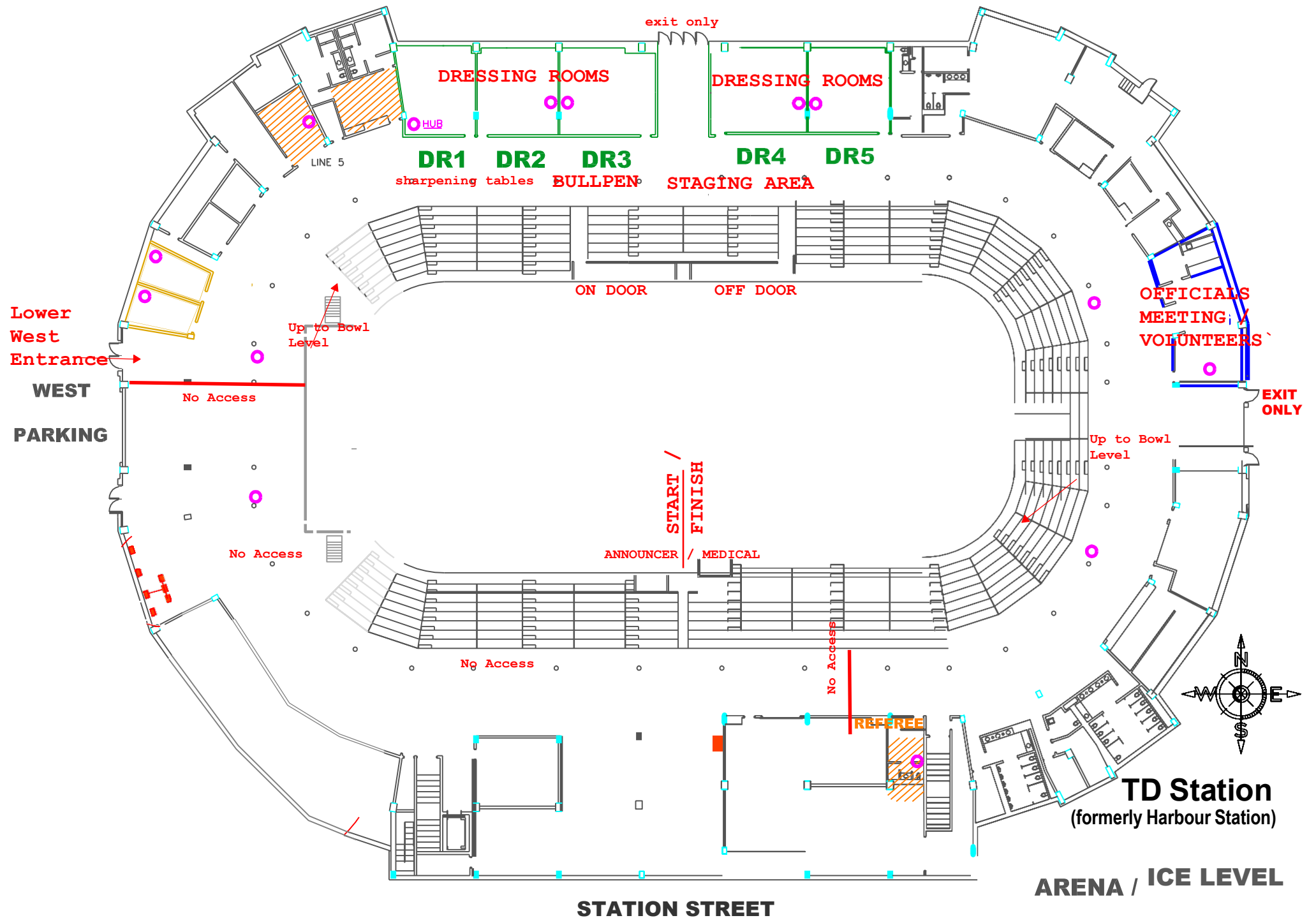

## THE BASICS OF ABILITY COMPETITIONS

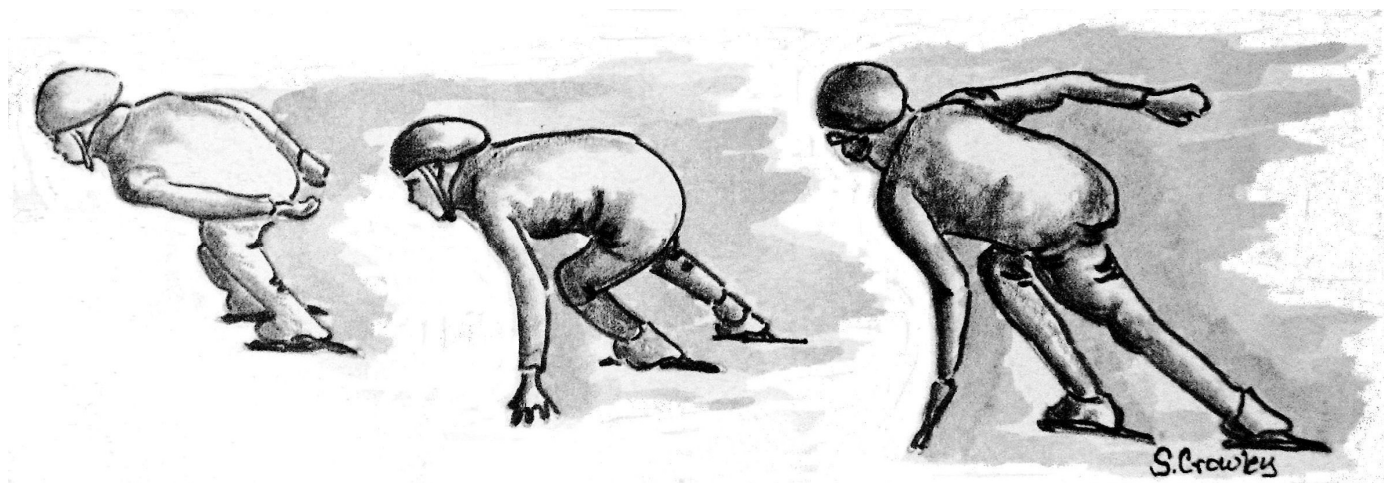
1. The Maritime Provinces run Ability Competitions on 85m, 100m and 111m tracks. Younger skaters use the shorter, narrower 85m track which requires smaller, lighter skaters to develop better technique and more lean.
2. The Ability competitions group skaters by ability (speed) only. In all divisions, males and females compete together. This ensures that all skaters have meaningful competition.
3. All participants skate a heat and a final for all races, with the exception of the last race, which may be skated as a final only, based on the ranking (accumulated points) from the previous races in that competition. The first place skater in each heat advances to the final along with the next fastest skater(s).
4. Divisions are seeded by times from the Meet Manager database for that season (database maintained by the Data Coordinator).
5. Recognition will be given to both genders within a division by awarding prizes to the top three male and the top three female skaters in each division.

**Starting Positions:** Starting line positions are randomly assigned by computer.

**Advancement to Finals** is by 1<sup>st</sup> place + time.

## REMINDERS

We ask you to note the following....

- Skaters are asked to only practice starts from the centre line for safety reasons. Corner starts are not allowed during warm-up.
- Check your equipment before you arrive at the bull pen. Helmets, helmet covers, neck guards, gloves, ankle protectors and safety glasses. Please ensure your laces are tied well and tucked in. It would be a shame to be disqualified for an equipment infraction having come all this way!
- Clubs are asked to ensure that their assigned dressing rooms are kept as tidy as possible. Additional charges may be levied against the Clubs responsible should additional cleaning be required.

## RACING RULES

The general skating rule is that the competitors, by their way of skating, shall contribute to the honest sporting and safe progress of the race in order to determine the result of the race on its merits. Breaches of the racing rules are considered as follows:

<b>FALSE START:</b>	<p>In the following situations the Starter shall declare a false start:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a) When a Competitor intentionally is slow in taking their starting position.</li><li>b) When one of the Competitors breaks from their mark, thereby causing the other Competitors to follow.</li><li>c) When a Competitor leaves the starting position after the word "Ready", but before the shot is fired.</li></ol> <p>* When the Starter calls the Competitors of the race for a New Start AFTER a False Start has been declared, then the Competitor committing <u>a next false start in this race</u> shall be disqualified from the race concerned.</p>
<b>OFF-TRACK:</b>	Shortening the distance to be skated with one or both skates on the left side of the curve marked by track marking blocks.
<b>IMPEDING:</b>	Deliberately impeding, blocking, charging, or pushing another competitor with any part of the body.
<b>ASSISTANCE:</b>	Permitting to give and/or receive assistance during a race. This will not apply to the push the skater receives from their team-mate in a relay event.
<b>TEAM SKATING:</b>	During a race any action that in any way is beneficial to the result of another is considered team skating and all involved shall be penalized. This does not apply to relay races.
<b>KICKING OUT:</b>	Deliberately kicking out of any skate during any part of a race thereby causing danger (including at the finish line, or throwing the body across the finish line) is forbidden and will lead to a penalty.
<b>PENALTY (DQ)</b>	<b>Penalized</b> (Disqualified) skaters receive last place points in a final.
<b>(DNF)</b>	A skater who does not finish a race, as a result of an infraction, will receive the points of the position ahead of those penalized.
<b>(DNS)</b>	A skater, who does not start in a Semi-Final, advances to the lowest final for that distance with the permission of the Chief Referee.
<b>(DNS)</b>	A skater, who does not start in a Final, receives no points for that Final.
